Frequently asked questions??

--What are the volunteer requirements?

There will be a 4 hour per child requirement with a maximum of 8 hour per family. The 4 hours need to be completed during one of the 3 tournaments hosted in July. During the season each league team is also required to run the concession stand. However, when you volunteer during the league season those hours do not count towards the 4 hours required. Your child's coach will inform you about what is needed to be covered during the teams league assigned times in the concession stand.

--Why charge the \$25.00 volunteer deposit?

We are implementing the volunteer deposit to have everyone participate in the operation of the league to do their part as over 60% of our revenues are generated during the tournaments and fund our entire league, not just tournament teams.

-- How will I get my \$25.00 returned to me after I work at the tournaments?

This fee will be reimbursed to you after the family requirement of 4 hours of work (8 hours if you have multiple kids in the league) is fulfilled. It is hopeful that this fee will help those who may be reluctant to help out, step up and become more involved in part of the league.

--Why do I need to work during the tournament even if my child did not make a tournament team?

The tournaments are a fundraiser for the entire league and not just the tournament teams.

--How are tournament teams selected?

Tournament teams are picked by all the coaches in each league by a secret ballot vote. All players in the league are placed on the nominating ballot to be selected from.
